Natural avalanche on Bridger Peak

On the drive up Bridger canyon this morning we noticed an avalanche on an east-northeast facing slope at the ridge near Bridger peak that was not previously noted or reported. Likely natural, possibly happened overnight or yesterday, but maybe earlier and went unnoticed? It looked 1-2' deep with rocks showing through parts of the <u>bed surface</u>. 200-250' wide. Debris did not appear to make it all the way down the chute to flatter runout. But, light was not great and all dimensions were difficult to confirm.
